Busselton Festival of Triathlon (BFOT) is owned and operated by Triathlon WA who are the not-for-profit, state sporting body for triathlon in Western Australia. In 2026, the event is excited to be celebrating its 25th year in Busselton.

In response to ongoing community feedback and growing athlete participation, several changes have been introduced for the 2026 event. The Busselton 100 (B100) event (long course) has shifted to a single lap bike course, and a new Busselton 50 (B50) event has been added. While the single lap course is less favourable for spectators and athletes, it enables a staged resident access plan for those living or operating businesses along the bike route to minimise the impact on the local community.

RESIDENT ACCESS PLAN

Based on event feedback, the BFOT team have developed a resident access plan to further assist the community during the event road closures. Please see the table below for the timings and specific information for each stage:

Time Period	Access Instructions
05:30 to 07:00	Resident/business access permitted (no bookings required) During this time period, all resident and business access will be possible via designated routes. Please allow additional travel time for detours along Layman Road at Navigation Way, and at Tuart Drive. During this time, residents can move vehicles as needed within the road closures.

Time Period	Access Instructions
07:00 to 13:30	No Vehicle Access Permitted During this time period, no vehicle access will be permitted due to the number of cyclists on the event course. For any unplanned urgent access enquiries, please call us on 08 6285 8550.

Emergency / Urgent Access

For any life threatening scenarios requiring a 000 emergency response please contact 000 directly, access will be available at all times for emergency services vehicles.
